Notice of Privacy Rights

We understand that the information provided by you and disclosed in counseling sessions is personal. Light Counseling, Inc., is required by law to maintain the privacy of your mental health information, to follow the terms set forth in this Notice, and to provide you with this Notice of our legal duties and privacy practices with respect to your mental health information. We are required by federal law to follow the terms of the Notice that is currently in effect.

There are three reasons that confidentiality will be vacated:

1. If you are a danger to yourself
2. If you are a danger to others
3. If abuse is disclosed

Therapists are mandated by their State Regulatory Boards to report any of the aforementioned, to protect you or others. In these instances, only the specific information of the immediate threat to self or someone else will be disclosed.

If there is a need to speak to a family member, physician, pastor, or any other pertinent individual, you must give permission **IN WRITING** to the therapist at Light Counseling. Without your expressed written consent, there can be no exchange of information with anyone other than that set forth in this Notice.

Your Rights

If you give your written consent for your therapist to speak to anyone concerning your mental health information, you have the right to revoke this at any time.

You have a right to request that Light Counseling amend your records if the information is incorrect or incomplete.
